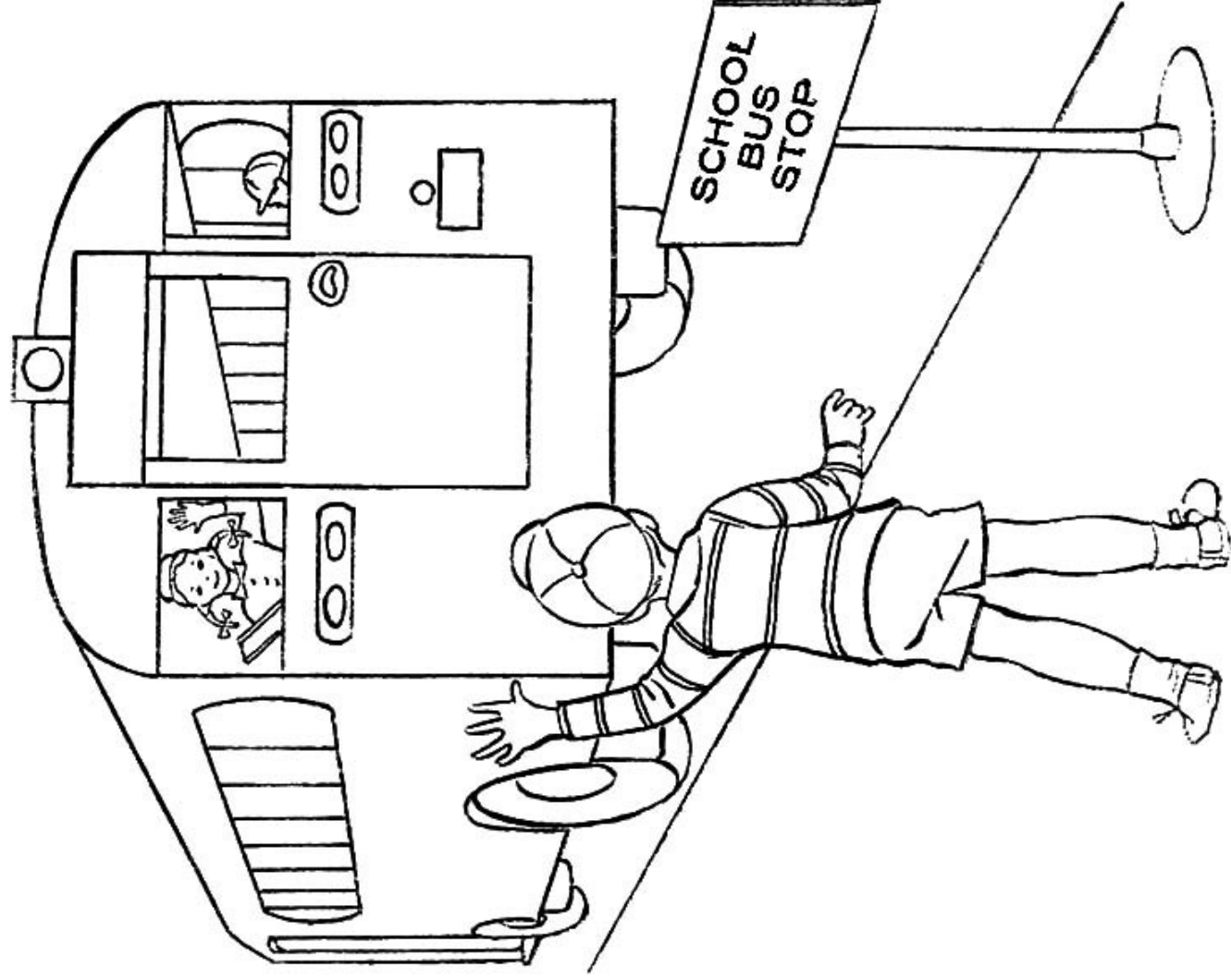


# THE SAFE KIDS GUIDE TO BUS STOP SAFETY

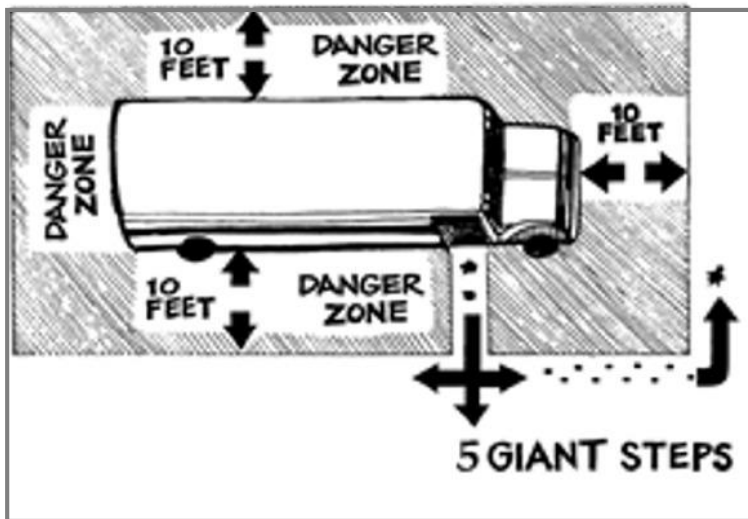
Taylor, Ethan, and Olivia all share a bus stop. They always follow the safety rules, and listen to their bus driver.



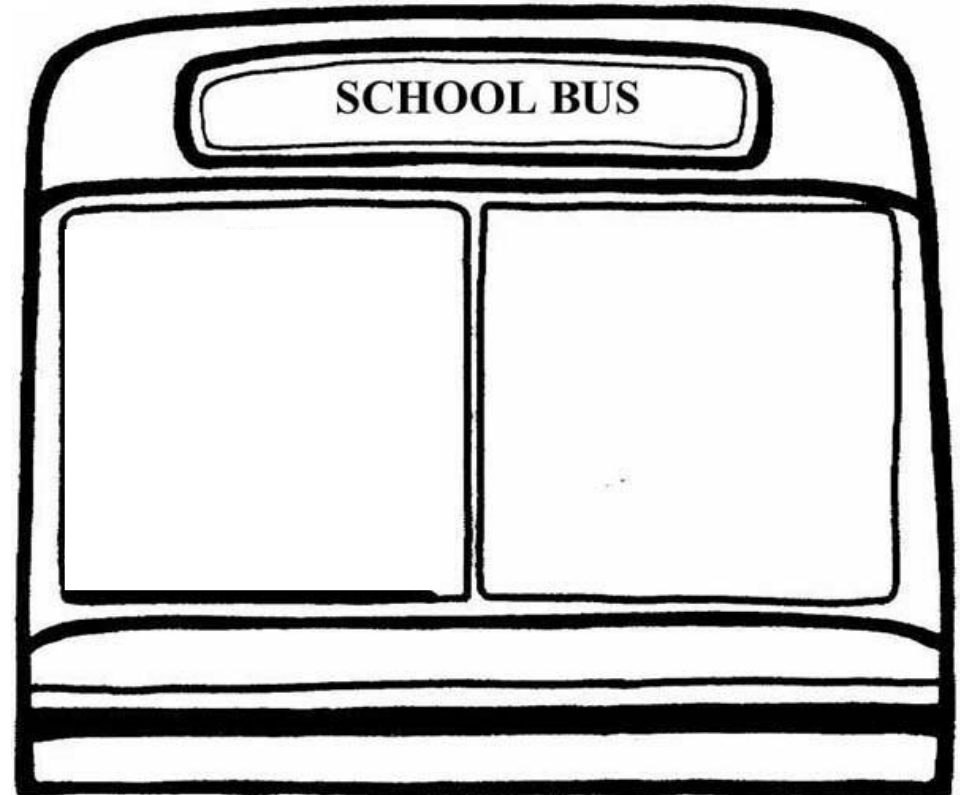
The DANGER ZONE is the area around the bus where kids can get hurt.

If you have to cross the street at your bus stop, take 5 GIANT steps away from the bus before crossing.

**Color** the bus yellow, the DANGER ZONE red, and the safe walking area in your favorite color.

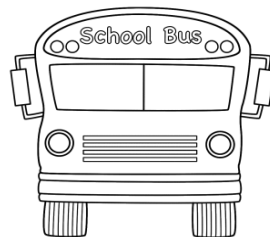
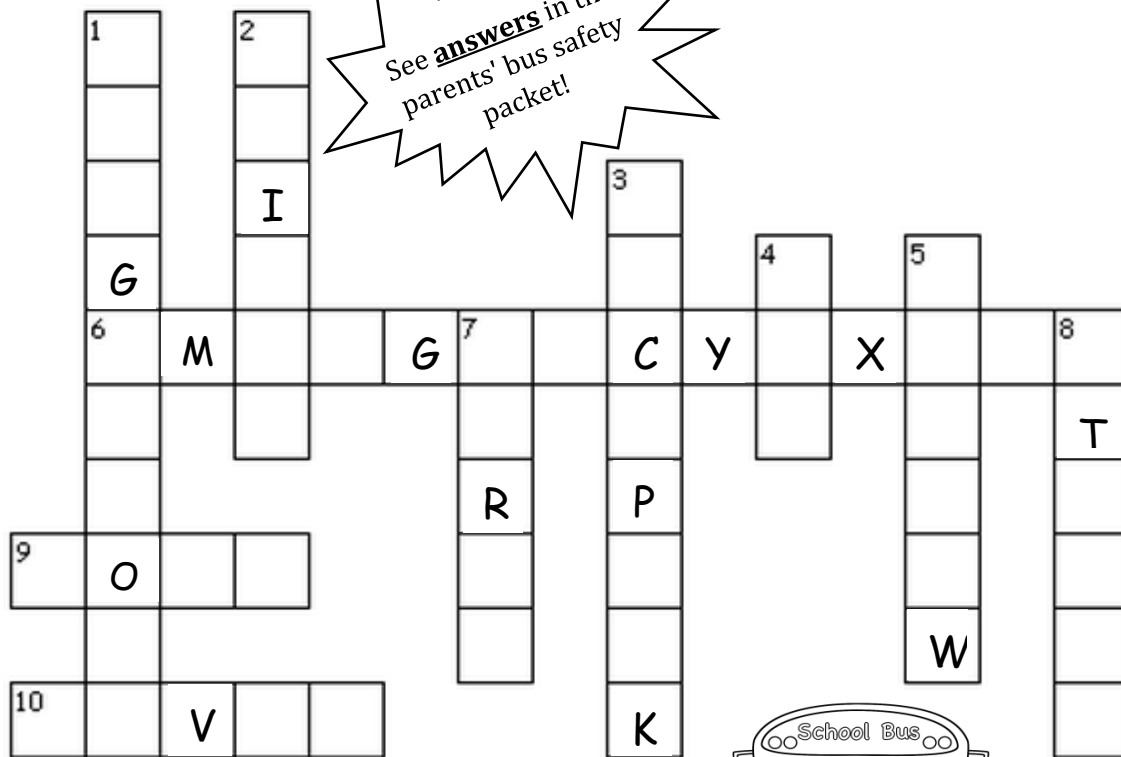


Always make sure your bus driver can see you. If you can't see them, it means they can't see you.



What does your bus driver look like? Draw your bus driver in the empty window.

If you **drop something** while you're getting off the bus, **NEVER** pick it back up.

Look around and make sure you are not in the **DANGER ZONE**, then, **ask the driver for permission** to pick up your dropped item.
